## January 22, 2012

Clay Cross gave the club's financial report. Membership status was updated. The club is purchasing new computer software to replace our approximately 20 year old set. Report approved.

Match Director reports followed as below:

Varmint and Shotgun matches have been cancelled. Any remaining supplies donated to the 4H Shooting Sports.

22 rimfire rifle, non-magnum Silhouette match - Lee Applegarth director. See web site for details of the match. To be held the first Saturday of the month at 9:00 AM. \$3 for one category or \$5 for both.

22 rimfire pistol, non-magnum Silhouette match - Lee Applegarth director. See web site for details. To be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of the month at 2:00 PM. \$5 fee.

IDPA Match - Mike Walls director. Still held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of each month. Check for starting times. Usually 9 AM October through April and 8 AM May through September. \$5 fee.

Bowling Pin Match - Mark Blackwood director. Still the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month at 2 PM. \$5 for 1<sup>st</sup> gun and \$3 each additional gun. A new supply of bowling pins is needed. If you know of, or have access to, a source for these, please contact Mark Blackwood.

4H Shooting Sports - Les Walz director. Great for the youth. Feel free to refer any youth 9 to 19 to them for details. First Sunday of the month 2 PM to 5 PM. Any volunteers to help with that program would be appreciated. They also need donations for purchase of ammo if you feel so inclined.

The Benefit Shoot for Special Olympics Arkansas will be held the 12<sup>th</sup> of May. The range will be closed Thursday the 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday the 11<sup>th</sup> for set up. This is for a great cause. Even if you do not wish to shoot, volunteers to help would greatly appreciated.

Old Business was next discussed. The NRA Grant Money Project was once again reviewed. It

was felt the funds could best be used to finish a road that would encompass the parking lots and give access via two routes. The cost will be \$4, 200 with the grant covering \$2,350 of that. The club voted to approve this item. Future plans to concrete under the main pistol and rifle range roofing will probably be the next improvement as funds allow.

The Delta Rivers Friends of the NRA made a presentation asking for volunteers from the club to help them in their events. The club has financially supported them. It is hoped that we can also get some members to donate some time as well. This is the arm of the NRA that is non-political and supports the youth programs, 4H, YHEC, Eddie Eagle, Women and Guns programs, etc. Our club has received 3 grants from them to improve the range. A big THANK YOU was given to Jerry Jacks and Don Smith for repairing the roof over the pistol side of the range and doing the roof extension.

New Business was next. The only item was that of the NRA Gun Raffle we have each year. Due to a paper work hold up we will have the gun and raffle tickets available at the June meeting with the drawing to be held at the next January meeting.
