

The meeting was held at the office of Paul Davis in the I-530 Medical Mall starting at 2:00 PM on Sunday June 27, 2010.

Financial report was given by Clay Cross and approved as submitted.

Increasing the club membership to 200 was discussed. Motion made and passed to do the same.

Match Director reports followed:

Varmint Shoot - need more participants. Contact Don Smith for more details.

Shotgun Shoot - discussion held on moving the date but that was tabled to the next meeting. Members encouraged to try this. Have the new electric thrower and is very challenging. Contact Don Smith.

IDPA Shoot - doing well. Lot of fun props and good training. Give it a try. Mike Walls named as new match director.

Bowling Pin Shoot - also a very fun shoot with mixture of pins, steel and centerfire/rimfire weapons. Contact Mark Blackwood.

4H Shooting Sports - doing well. They appreciate the club very much. Club voted to donate \$500 to them for ammo and supplies. Any youth age 9 to 19 may participate. Contact Les Walz.

Benefit Shoot for Special Olympics AR - did well again raising around \$2,500 for this fine organization. Club voted to let us sponsor this again next year. Any and all help appreciated with this event. Will be the second Saturday in May 2011.

Old business was next discussed. Range improvements in Bays 2 & 3 included the building of retaining walls and strengthening of the berms. Trash cleaned out. Bay 2 has the steel plate rack set up. You are not to engage the steel at less than 10 yards. It is limited to pistol caliber guns of 45 ACP or less or 22 LR or similar caliber rifles. Props, barrels, etc are not to be used as targets or target stands. There are stands for your use in the pistol bays and bring your own for the rifle range. No shooting at items on the ground. Once again make sure that your bullet impacts the berm when fired. Clean up after yourself.

Friends of the NRA Raffle is ongoing now. 200 tickets to be sold at \$10 each with the drawing for the Weatherby shotgun to be held at the next meeting. Get tickets from Clay Cross. Let's try and sell all of those if we can.

Safety Orientation Requirements were discussed. Motion passed to have Mike Walls and Chuck Cunningham come up with a power point presentation for that purpose to show at meetings or to new members. This was felt to be best to provide a consistent approach to the data. Will have to have done that in the future to get your membership renewed.

New business next covered. Motion made and passed to take 1 of the 300 yard benches and 2 of the 200 yard benches and remove the seats so as to allow better handicap access and let shooters bring their own chairs for a better fit. That will be done by some of the varmint shooters. It was

requested that we check into the feasibility of getting more gravel to put under the covers at Bays 2 & 3 and the shotgun area. Cost and estimates to be obtained and if not significant board will act on this issue. Also we may need eventually to add more stand holders in the ground.

Motion was made and passed to once again be a Freedom \$1,250 sponsor for the Friends of the NRA Banquet to be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday in September. Watch the web site for details of the event. Members are encouraged to attend. This group is nonpolitical and does the youth, women and grant functions.

Dues were payable by July 1<sup>st</sup>!! If not already paid do so immediately.
